

They'll work with singing professionals and qualified clinicians for a day of new and exciting singing experiences.

Who? Any high school singers from San Diego County. Middle school students accepted on recommendation of their choral teacher.

Why? To introduce young singers to an authentic American musical art form in four-part a cappella harmony. Reinforce good vocal skills (freely produced, well-supported, resonant tone), while singing with other students in a healthy social setting -- AND HAVING FUN!!!
